

## SURVEY Township of Brick

1. What is the primary operating radio frequency band (VHF, UHF, UHF-t, 7/800) for your:
  - a. Police Department - **450 MHz – P25 Conventional with Encryption.**
  - b. Fire Department – **450 MHz – P25 and Analog Conventional.**
  - c. EMS – **460 MHz – P25 and Analog Conventional.**
  - d. DPW – **450 MHz – P25 Motorola Moto-Turbo Trunking and Analog Conventional.**
  - e. BOE – **450 MHz – P25 Motorola Moto-Turbo Trunking.**
  
2. What is your migration plan once 500MHz Trunked Radio System is decommissioned by Federal Regulation in 2021?
  - a. **The Township of Brick will remain on the 450 through 470 MHz Band width for their normal day-to-day operations for all agencies.**
  - b. **The Township is in the process of migrating all of the Fire Division and EMS Divisions communications to newer P25 Trunking/conventional Dual and Tri Mode portables and mobiles.**
  - c. **The Police will have several mobile and fixed cross-band communications capabilities that be controlled by the Town and will allow interoperability between our current Police P25 DES-OFB Encrypted radios and the proposed County P25 Trunking – AES Encrypted 7/800 system.**
  
3. Do you currently own or plan to purchase radio capable of operating on the County's new P25 700 MHz Trunked Radio System?
  - a. **Yes. We are currently in the process of completing a full migration plan for the Township.**
  
4. Do you currently own or plane to purchase radios capable of AES Encryption?
  - a. **Yes.**
  
5. Do you have a need to have interoperable radio communications with State agencies?
  - a. **Yes. We currently have hardware in place that allows every Fire and EMS apparatus to have multiple capabilities of interagency operability including VHF, UHF and 7/800 MHz.**
