Dear Anonymous Requestor,

Attached along with this correspondence are documents in response to your April 21, 2022 records request. These documents are in addition to the dozens of documents previously provided.

The League continues to work to fulfill your records request as it pertains to email communications. However, as I have previously noted in our initial response dated April 29, 2022, your request seeks a voluminous number of emails. Over 325,000 emails, amounting to well over half-a-million pages. Each page of each email and attachment needing to be reviewed for possible redaction or exemption from production in accordance with applicable law. The large number of emails is mostly because the search terms you have requested; "OPRA" and "Open Public Records Act", appear in the signature of nearly every email sent by the League, and many of the emails received by the League. While the emails contain the term OPRA and/or Open Public Records Act, the actual subject matter of email is not necessarily related to the Open Public Records Act, which appears to be the records you wish to receive.

By way of example, I have included two Excel spreadsheets. The first, entitled "OPRA and vauss" includes the search results for emails containing the terms "OPRA" and "vauss" for the period between January 1, 2018 and April 20, 2022. Similarly, the second spreadsheet entitled "OPRA and elouise mcdaniel" include the search results for emails containing the terms "OPRA" and "elouise mcdaniel" for the same time period. These spreadsheets include the date the email was received or sent, who the email is from and to, the email's subject, and a brief excerpt of the email.

In reviewing these reports it would appear that there are very few, if any, emails relevant to the spirit of your records request. This pattern continues when a search is performed using the other terms in your request. Regardless, it is not my place to say nor is it required for a records custodian to try to infer what records a requestor would find relevant. However, with the goal of preserving League resources and your own, I find it would be beneficial if you could provide additional clarity regarding your request.

To that end, I respectfully request a brief call with you, to confer and ensure your request returns the specific records you seek and does not include records that may be irrelevant or outside the scope of your intended search. Kindly reach out to me at your convenience to 609-695-3481 x. 137.

At this time, without further clarification being providedt, additional time will be needed to fulfill your request. An extension until at least **September 21, 2022** will be required.
