Good day,

The Ocean County Sheriff's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on or about April 24, 2019. The official Records Custodian, Lt. Joseph Greene, received your OPRA request on April 24, 2019. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is May 2, 2019. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 3rd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

The following records were requested:

- See attached request

The records are partially enclosed. In the spirit of cooperation and in good faith on the part of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, I have included all requested files in the file format that was listed in the request with the exception of the "CAD comments". If the "CAD comment" field is imperative to your request, I am respectfully requesting an extension of two weeks from today's date. The reason for the extension request is to compile the information needed to assess a special service charge for the potential redaction of sensitive information that may in fact be present in any of the approximately 5,300 call for service. It has been brought to my attention that it is common practice for information such as lock box combinations, garage door codes, and spare key locations to be listed within the "CAD comments". The release of such information could be a detriment to the citizens that we serve.

The decision to redact the aforementioned information from the "CAD comments" is governed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1(10) which states:

"10) Emergency or security information or procedures for any buildings or facility which, if disclosed, would jeopardize security of the building or facility or persons therein" are exempt from the rules of OPRA.

Please advise me of your acceptance or rejection for my request for an extension at your earliest convenience. If you accept the request for an extension, the new deadline would be May 15, 2019.

This response is being communicated with you via e-mail as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Ocean County Sheriff's Office to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may

Please provide an export of the fields of digital data contained within the Active911 dispatch software in electronic spreadsheet (Excel or CSV) format detailing all alarms / calls for the period of March 1st, 2019 to March 31st, 2019.

If you intend to claim that the department does not have access to this information, please be advised that Active911 computer systems have confirmed that there is an account that has been created under the name "Ocean County Fire & EMS" registered to the department's address at 138 Chestnut Street, Toms River. I will provide a screenshot of this information upon request.

I am requesting all columns of the fields of data in spreadsheet / excel electronic format, which include: id received sent priority description details external_data place addressunit cross_street city state lat lon coordinate_source source units cad_code map_code map_id alert_key messages responses

The Active911 web interface should allow this data to be exported in CSV or similar original electronic format from the "alarms" tab of the web interface.
